

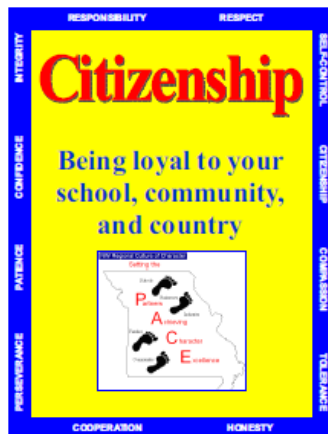

**Students:** Electronic devices such as cell phones, MP3 players, I-pods, are not allowed during the school day in and out of classes and should be put away ONCE you enter the school building. If cell phones or

other electronic devices are visible they will be confiscated by Mr. Turpin and students will have consequences outlined in the handbook.

**Students:** Items are not allowed to be taken from the cafeteria after breakfast or lunch. No outside food and drink is permitted other than your cold lunch.

**Students:** No fidget spinners will be allowed at school. If taken out, they will be confiscated.

**Students:** Ineligible students will not be allowed to participate in or attend extra-curricular activities. This includes home and away athletic contests, dances, and activities sponsored by school organization and clubs.

**Reminder: In order to continue to participate in extra-curricular activities such as football, softball, baseball, volleyball, basketball, cheerleading, prom, dances, track meets, golf, etc. you need to have an attendance percentage of 90% or above and not be on the ineligible list.
