

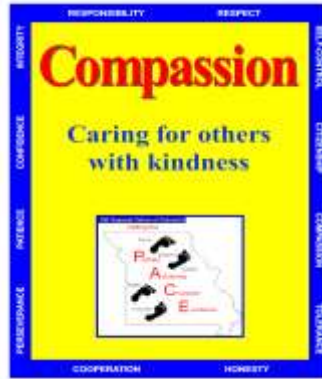

Standard Expected Practices
